

January Program Was Presented by Tony Millet

“Hybridizing, sowing orchid seed and growing out seedlings”

Tony Millet, well-known orchid hybridizer and grower entertained and fascinated us with his talk on hybridizing orchids. Tony has been doing his own hybridizing for over 20 years and enjoys making hybrids using hard to find, rare or unusual color forms of species. Tony has more than 30 RHS registered hybrids and is an AOS Student Judge. Tony began his talk giving us tips on dealing with the cold weather, brrrr. If we are experiencing 40°F and the weather is dry, the plants will be okay but beware if there will be rain. Low temperatures and wet weather spell trouble for our plants. We also need to be concerned if we will have three consecutive days of cold, windy and rainy weather. Five to seven consecutive days of cold weather is an orchid emergency! Remember, that species and certain genera like Vandas, Dendrobiums, Grammatophyllums and Bulbophyllums tend to be more cold-sensitive than most Cattleya hybrids.

Bring inside or otherwise protect the following:

- Budded plants
- Valuable plants
- Seedlings
- Vandas
- Phalaenopsis
- Cattleya violacea & primary crosses
- Cattleya nobilior
- Cattleya walkeriana
- Grammatophyllums

Next, Tony explained that flasking can be done very simply at home using common household items and no special equipment. The nutrient solution, or agar, may be made using household items or purchased commercially. Making your own hybrids allows you to grow new crosses versus buying the same crosses as everyone else.

Tony then demonstrated how to pop off an orchid's anther cap, remove the pollinia with a toothpick and pollinate the desired pod parent. After pollination, the flower itself will wilt and dry and the seed capsule begins to form. Once the pod is mature, it is time to flask!

Tony explained how we can use a clear plastic bin to create our own sterile flasking box. Holes are cut in the front of the box and rubber gloves are attached so that the inside of the box remains sterile. Before beginning, the box is sprayed with a bleach solution. A sterile nutrient solution in a sterile flask or jar (may be either glass or plastic) provides support for the growing seedlings. Next, the pod is opened and the seeds scraped out and put into the flask. The seedlings will begin to grow and will need to be repeatedly moved into new flasks – or replated – to replenish the nutrients and prevent the seedlings from becoming overcrowded. After one to two years, the seedlings will be large enough to survive outside the flask.

Once the seedlings are removed from the flask, they are washed and potted into community pots. Tony selects the healthiest of the seedlings and discards the rest. After anywhere from two to five years, the plants will be large enough to flower.

While this process certainly seems easy enough, I think we can all appreciate the amount of time and labor that goes into growing the beautiful blooming plants we see available for sale!


