#### **Our Speaker For August Is Mark Margolis**



Mark is a retired Dade County Public school teacher and a non-commercial hobby back yard grower of orchids. Mark has been growing orchids for over 35 years. While he grows many different types of orchids, the Catasetum group is his favorite. He has over 600 plants from this family. Over the years he and his plants have received over 50 AOS awards. He is still looking for his first FCC.

#### The July Program "Prevention and Diagnosis of Orchid Pests and Disease" was presented by Sandi Jones of Broward Orchid Supply

Sandi Jones of Broward Orchid Supply presented a great program on controlling pests and diseases in our orchids. Broward Orchid Supply carries all the products to keep the bugs, bacteria and fungus under control. Sandi

began her presentation by suggesting that we should determine the type of orchids that we have and group them by their light and water requirements, being aware of the need for good air circulation and spacing.

**PESTICIDES:** One of the most annoying bloom busters are the tiny thrips that eat at the orchid flower spikes and roots. You can identify thrip damage when you see the edges of your blooms turn white or see black rings on the roots. Thrips can best be controlled with a systemic insecticide like Orthene. Good for also controlling white flies, Orthene should be applied twice, one week apart, then monthly to keep the bugs under control. Another pricey systemic insecticide is Merit. (\$85.00 for 2oz) Merit only needs to be applied 4 times a year. Permetrol will also provide systemic for control of thrips, scale and mealy bugs. Malathion can be used for topical insect control of scale and mealy bugs, but high ph water will cause it to break down and become ineffective faster. Try Orange Guard for organic pet safe control. It is used for topical control of ants, scale, thrips and aphids. Oils like Neem oil can be used for topical, pet safe control of most pests. Oils, however should be used only in the early morning or late afternoon when temperature are lower. Plain old dish soap, (Sandi likes Ajax Triple Action), can be spayed on orchids for insect control and this can even be mixed with insecticides. Use 2 oz. per gal in a sprayer, but add the soap after you have mixed the chemical with water or your mix will bubble out. Remove the brown sheaths from your orchids to expose scale and remove hiding places. Ants are usually present as farmers for aphids and scale. To control slugs, Sandi recommends Sluggo bait, but cautions not to over use.

**FUNGICIDES:** In our wet South Florida summer, rots, fungus, spots and crud are always a problem and must be dealt with. Never be tempted to yank yellow leaves off your orchids, because the tiny tears caused by the yanking are conduits for fungus, rot and bacteria. Cinnamon can be put on cuts. Botritis shows up on flowers a tiny black spots. Black sooty mold shows up on the back side of dendrobiums. Fusarium wilt presents as a plant that won't thrive with roots and leaves that wilt. Take the plant from it's pot and inspect the roots to see how the plant is doing. All affected parts of the plant must be cut away. Rot spreads quickly and looks like a soft black spot. Straight isopropyl alcohol will make rot bubble. Full strength hydrogen peroxide can be used on Crown rot. Thiomyl is a systemic controller of fungus and is effective on brown spot. It is used at a rate of 1.5 tsp. per gal.) Control of soft rot fungus at a rate of 1.5 T per gal. Dithane (1.5 T per gal.)can be mixed with Thiomyl (1.5 tsp. per gal.) and Orthene (at 1 tsp per gal.) for a 1 stop pest and fungus killer. This formula should be applied with a pump sprayer twice 7-10 days apart then used monthly. Always use gloves when mixing or spraying chemicals and respirators are also recommended.

**SUPPLEMENTS:** Sandi recommends Dyna Grow Pro-Tekt which is a silicon supplement that is used to toughen the plant to help resist pest damage and make it more heat and cold tolerant. Kiki Pro is used to promote new growth and flowers. Spreader Stickers are used with topical products to keep them from washing off as quickly. Use TSP to sterilize your pruners between plants to prevent spreading disease.

Sandi concluded by asking all members to consider a membership in the American Orchid Society and offered a 10% discount to AOS members. She also is looking for volunteers to assist with the orchid care at the Bonnet House.
