MARCH 2019 SPEAKER
ALEX LAMAZARES
ORCHIDMANIA SOUTH FLORIDA



Alex Lamazares delivers on a promise to provide assistance to children with HIV/AIDS in our community, by tendering a check from **OrchidMania South Florida** to Dr. Ana Garcia of Project Cradle, the Pediatric Infectious Disease and Immunology program at the University of Miami Miller School of Medicine.

A child comes into the world totally helpless. Nothing could be sadder than for these children to be born with AIDS and fighting for their lives. Every year in the last week-end of May, an all volunteer charitable organization OrchidMania sells orchids and other plants at Dante Fascell Park, South Miami to benefit the children born with AIDS. This is part of Project Cradle, a program at the UM School of Medicine, Dept of Pediatric Infectious Disease and Immunology.

The event will help raise funds for the pediatric AIDS program at the University of Miami Miller School of Medicine, which helps children in the community with HIV/AIDS. In previous years, the sale has raised between \$10,000 and \$16,000, which has been donated to the AIDS program. The program provides services that the government doesn't provide for, such as transportation to be treated at the clinic. The program also provides vouchers for children to eat while they are at the clinic.

The effort was organized by Alex Lamazares and run exclusively by volunteers. On every Sunday for a full year before the sale, volunteers take care of donated orchids. This entails trimming dead roots and stems, repotting and fertilizing them in the greenhouse, so they will look their best for the sale. The group has been conducting the orchid sales since 1998.

The volunteers take special care of other plants donated to the society. These include begonias, hoyas, bromeliads, plumerias and palms.

Others help out with the setting up and sales of orchids. Perhaps most enjoyable is matching up the right person with the right plant or plants.

"The support that these children need is entirely dependent on the success of the event. The more people we get to come out, the more money we'll be able to raise and the more children we'll be able to provide services for,"

TIPS TRICKS FROM Peg Geria

Home Depot carries cedar planks in various lengths and widths. I have created many new mounts for plants that are ready to be transplanted by cutting pieces to different lengths. I've drilled holes to not only attach the orchids but also supply a few crevices for the new roots. I use zip ties to attach the new plants since they hold the plant securely to the plank which allows the roots to take hold. The planks are cheaper than baskets and terra cotta pots and allow the roots to attach as in nature.

TIPS TRICKS AND FOOD FOR THOUGHT

What's the Difference between a clone and a hybrid?

A hybrid just means that the plant has 2 different parent plants meristem is a clone of a plant. There are 3 ways to propagate orchids.

One is to divide the orchid and then each of those divisions will be the exact same plant.

The next is to use pollen from one plant and fertilize another plant or pollen from itself and get a seed pod. This method is like having children. No 2 plants will be exactly the same. The flowers will all be different.

The last way is the meristem. In this method a piece of tissue is taken from a plant and then is grown in a lab to produce exact replicas of a certain plant. A meristem plant can be a hybrid if the tissue is taken from a hybrid.

Note: Species plants are as they would be found in the wild.

How to create a shallow wooden basket

Home Depot and many orchid suppliers carry wooden baskets for growing orchids, sometimes these baskets are too deep and will hold more water than your orchids can handle. The solution? Shorten up your baskets by removing slats.

You can make baskets more shallow – even almost flat – by undoing the wires at the bottom and removing slats. The bottom piece comes off in one piece, to be replaced at your desired depth. Used a Leatherman type tool, the smallest chisel-type end to pry the wire open from the bottom and then straighten with pliers ends to



I used left over basket slats to make another basket. Didn't have enough longer slats, so I used shorter cross-members and made a rectangular basket.
