Brian Monk of Blu Llama Orchids "Orchid Photography"

We are very lucky to have, Brian Monk of Blu Llama Orchids, Inc. from Naples, FL. Brian will do his presentation on, "Orchid Photography" in which Brian has won many awards, etc.

Brian Monk was born in Milton, FL. in 1969. Shortly after his birth, Brian's family moved to Charlston, W.V. where he spent the next 18 years. Because of his ego, he will continue this bio in the third person. As a young man, Brian's intense passion for nature let to his profession and his many hobbies, including bird-watching, orchid growing, fly fishing and natural history.

In 1992, Brian received his B.S. cum laude, from Hampden Sydney College in VA. Followed by his Doctorate of Veterinary Medicine from Virginia Tech in 1997. In 2005, he moved to Ft. Lauderdale, and

established Blu Llama Orchids,Inc. (Blu with no "E"). In 2015, Dr. Monk moved to Naples FL., built a 3000 sq.ft. green house and opened a lab for orchid seedlings and tissue culture. In 2017, Hurricane Irma destroyed his greenhouse and practically wiped out his collection of almost 1000 plants. Blu Llama Orchids folded as a consequence. He has been in the process of re-building his collection, and recently re-opened his lab for new customers. He currently resides in Naples, FL., with his four ungrateful cats, a Boston Terrier with a tennis ball addiction and a French Bulldog with a passion for home security.

Brian started growing orchids at the age of 14, which gives him almost 40 years of experience. He has killed roughly his weight in orchids at least twice. He will grow anything green, but focuses on his hybridizing projects, which include the development of heat-tolerant Cymbidiums, intergeneric Brazilian Miltonia hybrids, and a standard pink Cattleya with an all white lip.

He is an award-winning semi-professional photographer who teaches seminars (both private and group), lectures on photography, and sells his limited edition prints. His images have won awards online, in the 2007 Miami International Orchid Show, and at the 2008 World Orchid conference, He has displayed as the solo artist at Henry P. Leu Gardens in Orlando, FL. He was a student judge with the American Orchid Society, and has lectured to many orchid societies, both in Florida and Nationwide, on his favorite topics (one of which you are about to hear)! 
Directions to Plantation Presbyterian Church
