OUR SPEAKERS FOR JULY:

SANDI JONES & TOM WELLS OF BROWARD ORCHID SUPPLY

Our speakers this month will be Sandi Jones and Tom Wells, co-owners of Broward Orchid Supply and Orchid Curators at the Bonnet House Museum & Garden in Ft. Lauderdale.

Tom will be speaking on advanced re-potting and answering any questions you may have. At this lecture, general cultural information and when to use what, i.e., fertilizers, fungicides, pesticides will be discussed. Got an orchid climbing out of its pot and don't know where to begin? Let us show you how to tackle that monster! Learn how often an orchid should be re-potted, how to divide an orchid, about different potting medias and the proper type of pot or basket to use. Common questions like what orchids do best on mounts or in landscaping; what do I use to attach the orchid to the mount; how to water after they are mounted; and what to do when an orchid starts to overgrow it's mount will be addressed. General cultural information and when to use what, i.e., fertilizers, fungicides, pesticides will also be discussed.
