## OUR FEBRUARY SPEAKER Jeff Adkins from Adkins Orchids

Our speaker this month is Mr. Jeff Adkins of Adkins Orchids. Jeff is known for his beautiful orchids as well as his skill as an AOS orchid judge. This, however, isn't Jeff's only talent. He is quite the master carpenter and is recognized for his expertise at building orchid greenhouses. A third generation grower, Jeff was influenced by both his mother and grandmother. Their exceptional orchids were always present in his life. He began his career at the legendary



Jones and Scully Nursery in Miami and in 1984 Jeff put together the Jones and Scully display for the 11th World Orchid Conference. He began his own business, Adkins Orchids, when J&S closed shop. The specialties of Adkins Orchids include big showy Cattleyas, Vandas and Dendrobiums. Jeff's topic this month is "The perfect orchid habitat". He is an expert at constructing strong and durable shade structures and custom greenhouses which are a wonderful addition to anyone's growing area. I'm sure we will learn a lot!









# THANKS TO OUR JANUARY SPEAKER Ruben Sauleda from Ruben in Orchids

Dr. Ruben P. Sauleda Gave us a beautiful slide presentation on bifoliate catteyas. He explained that most bifoliate are from Brazil and as you would expect they have 2 leaves. He suggests that we repot bifoliates when the roots

just begin to grow. That means you might have to sacrifice the flower. He pots his bifoliates in hydratone to prevent snow mold. If snowmold becomes a problem Physan should be used.
