Professor Catharine Mannion

Presentation on orchid pests

Catharine Mannion is a Professor and Extension Specialist with the University of Florida, Tropical Research and Education Center. She has been with the University of Florida for 18 years. She is responsible for developing a research and extension program on integrated pest management of ornamental plants with an emphasis on invasive pests. Her research has focused on the biology and management of several introduced pests such as whiteflies, scales, thrips and weevils in both the landscape and in production. She works closely with county agents and other clientele on the development of extension outreach products and science-based materials. She received a B.S. degree in Biological Sciences from University of California, a M.S. degree in Entomology from North Carolina State University, and a Ph.D. in Entomology from the University of Florida

NOBILE DENDROBIUMS BY JOHN ROMANO

Last month we had John Romano speak to us about nobile dendrobiums, which he has grown in South Florida with great success and he has also received many AOS awards.

The nobile dendrobiums are also called soft cane dendrobiums. They are deciduous, which means they shed their leaves in the winter. They like a dry winter rest and then will flower in spring. In Asia the nobile dendrobium grows on rocks. Some of these flowers can last for two to three months.

John grows his nobile dendrobiums in plastic pots with sphagnum moss without any rocks or Styrofoam peanuts in the bottom of the pot. He repots the plant every two years after blooming so he can replace the sphagnum moss that breaks down and that is when he repots any keikis (baby plants) that may be growing on the plant. When repotting John often dips the plant in a solution of one teaspoon of Dip-N-Grow dissolved in one gallon of water before repotting into fresh sphagnum moss.

Light: John gives these dendrobiums bright light, at least six hours of direct sun per day. John stated if you can give more light after Thanksgiving that is better. John recommends a south exposure in the winter and he also provides the plant with lots of air movement.

Water: John recommends watering after flowering and throughout the summer when you see new roots and new growth. After Thanksgiving keep the plant dry, do not water but rain water is okay. Do not water again until the buds are fully formed.

Fertilizer: Start fertilizing in spring when watering and the plant is growing. John said you can also use Superthrive or Megathrive. He said you can use a timed release fertilizer in spring after bloom. After Labor Day discontinue all fertilizer.

Pests: John states the best way to keep pests away is good air flow, high humidity and to water underneath the leaves to avoid mites. If you do have pests, you can use one part rubbing alcohol, one part Formula 409 and two parts water in a spray bottle to spray the plant. Hydrogen peroxide can be used on the plants for insects, snails, slugs and rot. Systemic insecticides can be used such as Orthene, Merit, Orthenex, Malathion and Mavrik.

In summary, John recommends giving the nobile dendrobium orchids lots of sun, air, water and fertilizer in the summer when they are growing. After Labor Day discontinue all fertilizer and after Thanksgiving give them no water to get beautiful blooms in spring.

Dendrobium anosmum canes can be six feet long with deciduous canes. Anosmum has often been used in hybridizing.




